### 4 h record book manual

Here are some tips for earning your Star Rank credits virtually and ideas on how to record them in your Record Book. Completing a 4H Record Book is a process where you record project and club work using a standard format. In this competency skill you identify, create, classify, archive and preserve records. It outlines all the parts of the Record Book and includes instructions for completing each form. NOTE Most school districts block access from outside of your school district. It is also likely that you will not be granted incoming access by your school account administrator. Please open a free, personal Google account to access this Record Book Forms feature.. This version allows you to complete the form directly into the document and expand the rows as needed. While society has changed, the goals of teaching recordkeeping to youth remain essentially the same. Members document their skill development and learning experiences in a written report. 4H members measure their achievements and growth. Completion of the Personal Development Report awards 4H members for participation in 4H activities, which provides an incentive for participation, learning, and achievement. Records management RM is an industry standard practice of identifying, creating, classifying, archiving, and preserving records. 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In addition to record keeping, the 4H Record Book gives members an opportunity to reflect on their year, measure their achievements and growth, and set goals and develop plans to meet those goals. Why have a 4H record book 4H record books give members an opportunity to reflect on their yearly work. They document their skill development and their learning experiences in a written report. 4H members measure their achievements and growth in their total years in 4H 4H record books encourage members to set goals, pursue strategies to meet those goals, and to shift gears in the face of challenges and obstacles. Completion of the Personal Development Report awards 4H members for participation in 4H activities, which provides an incentive for participation, learning, and achievement. Completing a 4H record book is a process where 4H members record project and club work. Records management is a competency skill to identify, create, classify, archive, and preserve records. The 4H record book teaches 4H members these skills through a standard format. Not Required for 4H Membership 4H record books are not required for membership or for participation in 4H activities, such as club events and activities, or for attending 4H camps or conferences. A 4H record book may be required to receive participation awards such as star ranking, medals, or pins based on 4H record book achievements. 2 Ways To Do A Record Book In California, we have two ways to complete a Record Book through our Online Record Book ORB or with a paper Record Book. Both versions are aligned with the same forms and follow the same instructions for completion. You can use either version as your Record Book. State 4H Record Book Competition The state record book competition is focused on selecting senior 4H members who have demonstrated outstanding achievement in their 4H project work. Books are judged against standard criteria.

toward a variety of 4H activities like paying for a 4H event, membership dues, fundraiser supplies or anything 4H related. Instructions are on form. It is used for State Conference, LDC, CLC and Youth Fest. Form must be complete and received not postmarked 10 days before the event registration due date. Colorado 4H Shooting Sports Ambassadors who apply will receive first consideration for the scholarship. It must be signed in 4HOnline.com in order to register. It covers what type of clothing can be worn, what type of logos and text is allowable and other information pertaining to apparel. If you are going to build a 4H club specific website, this document provides guidance on what is allowable. This publication will be reviewed annually by the Colorado 4H Roundtable. This policy manual addresses topics usually associated with delivery of 4H programs in the organized club setting. However, many items may also pertain to other 4H delivery methods. 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Put events information on your calendar. Start a Project Report Form for each of your projects. Record talks and activities on your PDR Form. Collect any letters, awards, newspaper clippings, pictures, or other 4H related items in a folder or box. Complete your PDR Form. Consult the Record Book Manual with questions. Ask your leaders for help. Write your 4H Story. Create a title page and table of contents. Assemble the PDR Form, 4H Story, Project Report Forms and Expression Pages, and any 4H related awards, newspaper clippings, or pictures. Turn in your Record Book at the last Community Club Meeting at the end of May. Ask to send it to Alameda County Judging. Due by April 15. A link will be sent via email by June 1 each year. Current year records are required for Skillathon. Those selected to represent Muskingum County in the State Achievement Awards Selection will have an opportunity to complete the state form before it is submitted for State Competition. State Achievement Award recipients win a trip to National 4H Congress, one of the

nations premier youth development events!
